YARN Manos Classica 100g skein

A = col 2171, Saturn
9 9 10 10

B = col 2800, Mercury
2 3 3 3

C = col 2264, Missouri
1 1 2 2

NEEDLES

1 pair each 6mm and 7mm

TENSION 15sts and 20 rows = 10cm square over stocking stitch using 7mm needles

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit;
p = purl;
st(s) = stitch(es);
k1b = knit into stitch in the row below;
folls = follows; **r**
ep = repeat;
patt = pattern;
beg = beginning;
dec = knit or purl next 2 stitches together;
inc = increase 1 stitch by knitting into back and front of next st;
s1 = slip the next stitch;
RS = rightside;
WS = wrongside;
m1 = pick up thread before the next stitch and knit into the back of it; k2tog = knit next 2 stitches together; alt = alternate;
cont = continue
SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS
t2L = twist to the left by, purl into back of 2nd st then knit the 1st stitch, take both stitches off needle together;
t2R = twist to the right by, knit the 2nd stitch then purl the 1st stitch, take both stitches off needle together;
y2rn = wind yarn twice round needle when knitting stitch;
spirals = when knitting the elongated stitch, twist it 3 half turns clockwise before knitting it through

the back of stitch;
yf = yarn forward;
yb = yarn back

BACK

Using 6mm needles and **A**, cast on 81(87:93:99)sts and work as folls:-

Row 1: p1, *k1, p1, rep from * to last 2sts, k2

Row 2: s1, *p1, k1b, rep from * to last st, k1

Row 3: s1, *k1b, p1, rep from * to last 2sts, k1b, k1

Rows 2-3 form fisherman rib.

Cont in rib until work measures 9cm(3.5ins)

Change to 7mm needles and work as folls:-

Stripe 1

Row 1: (RS) using **C**, purl

Row 2: knit

Rows 3-4: using **B**, purl

Row 5: using **C**, purl

Row 6: knit

Row 7: using **A**, p4(7:10:13), *m1, p9, rep from * to last

5(8:11:14)sts, m1, p5(8:11:14) 90(96:102:108)sts

Change to patt 1

Row 8: WS facing, *k1, t2L, rep from * to end

Row 9: *p1, t2L, rep from * to end

Row 10: k2, *t2L, k1, rep from * to last st, p1

Row 11: *t2L, p1, rep from * to end

Row 12: *t2L, k1, rep from *to end

Row 13: k1, p1, *t2L, p1, rep from * to last st, k1

Rows 14- 25: rep rows 8-13 twice

Row 26: WS facing, using **B**, k4(7:10:13), *k2tog, k8, rep from * to last 6(9:12:15)sts, k2tog,

k4(7:10:13) 81(87:93:99)sts

Rows 27-29: knit

Change to stripe 2

Row 30: using **C**, knit y2rn across row

Row 31: slip all sts onto RH needle, undoing the y2rn

Row 32: using **B**, spirals
Rows 33-35: knit

Change to patt 2

Row 36: using **A**, purl

Row 37: RS facing, *p1, t2R, rep from * to end

Row 38: *k1, t2R, rep from * to end

Row 39: p2, * t2R, p1, rep from * to last st, k1

Row 40: *t2R, k1, rep from * to end

Row 41: *t2R, p1, rep from * to end

Row 42: k2, *t2R, k1, rep from * to last st, p1

Rows 43-54: rep rows 37-42 twice

Work stripe 1 again, (rows 1-6)

Next row: using **A**, purl

Change to body patt

Row 1: WS facing, k2(1:2:3), *p1, k3, rep from * to last 3(2:3:4)sts,

p1, k2(1:2:3)

Row 2: p2(1:2:3), *k1, p3, rep from * to last 3(2:3:4)sts, k1,

p2(1:2:3)

Row 3: work as row 1

Row 4: using **B**, p2(1:2:3), *yb, s1, yf, p3, rep from * to last 3(2:3:4)sts, yb, sl ,yf, p2(1:2:3)

Row 5: k2(1:2:1), *yf, sl, yb, k1, rep from * to last 1(0:1:0)st,

k1(0:1:0)

Row 6: using **A**, work as row 2
These 6 rows form body patt.

Cont in patt until work measures 51cm(20ins) ending with a WS row

Armholes
Cast off 4(5:6:7)sts beg next 2 rows

73(77:81:85)sts
Cont in body patt until armhole measures 23cm(9ins)

Shape shoulders

Cast off 8(9:9:10)sts beg next 4 rows

Cast off 9(9:10:10)sts beg next 2 rows

Cast off

LEFT SLEEVE

#Using 6mm needles and A, cast on 33(33:35:35)sts and work 7cm in fisherman rib as back.

Change to 7mm needles and **C**.
Work as folls:-

Row 1: RS, p2(2:3:3), *p3, m1, p3, rep from * to last 1(1:2:2)sts,

p1(1:2:2) 38(38:40:40)sts

Change to stripe 1

Rows 2-6: work as rows 2-6 on back

Row 7: sizes S and M, using **A**, inc, *p6, m1, rep from * to last st,

m1, p1# 45sts

sizes L and XL, using **A**, *p2, m1, p3* rep from * to end

48sts

Rows 8-20: work as rows 8-13 on back, inc each end of sleeve rows 11 and 17, working extra sts into patt.

##Work stripe 1 again, (rows 2-6), inc each end of row 5 51(51:54:54) sts

Next row: sizes S and M, using **A**, p1, *m1, p7, rep from * to last st,

m1, p1 59sts

sizes L and XL, using **A**, *p3, m1, p3, rep from * to end

63sts

Change to body patt

Row 1: WS facing, k3, *p1, k3, rep from * to end

Con in body patt, inc each end of every 6th row to 75(75:79:79)sts

Continue without shaping until work measures 48cm(19ins). Cast off.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Work # to # as left sleeve

45(45:48:48)sts

Rows 8-20: work in patt 2, starting as row 36 of back, inc each end of sleeve rows 11 and 17

Work ## to ## as left sleeve

LEFT FRONT (knitted sideways)

Begin at centre front. Using 7mm needles and **C**, cast on 60sts. Work as folls:-

Row 1: RS, p60, cast on 3sts

Row 2: using B, knit y2rn

Row 3: slip sts undoing y2rn

Row 4: using **C**, inc, spirals to end 64sts

Row 5: using **A**, *p4, m1, p5, rep from * to last st, p1 71sts

Change to patt 2

Row 6: cast on 2sts, *k1, t2R, rep from * to last st, k1

Rows 7-16: Cont with patt 2, casting on 3sts at beg of rows 8, 12 and 16, and 2sts beg rows 10 and 14 86sts

Row 17: using **C**, *p4, p2tog, p4, rep from * to last 6sts, p6, cast on 3sts 81sts

Rows 18-20: work as rows 2-4 82sts

Row 21: using **A**, *p7, m1, p8, rep from * to last 7sts, p7 87sts

Change to body patt

Row 22: cast on 3sts, k2, *p1, k3, rep from * to end

Rows 23-32: cont with body patt, casting on 2sts, beg rows 24 and 28, casting on 3sts beg rows 26 and 30 and casting on 12sts beg row 32 112sts

Rows 33-48: cont with body patt, dec at shoulder edge on rows 38, 43 and 48 109sts

Row 49: using **C**, *p7, p2tog, p7, rep from * to last 13sts, p7, p2tog, p4 102sts

Row 50: knit

Rows 51-52: using **B**, purl

Important:

We recommend buying enough yarn to complete a project. If there is a great difference between skeins, we recommend knitting two rows from one skein and two rows from another skein to give an overall blended effect.

Row 53: using **C**, purl to last 2sts, p2tog

Row 54: knit

Row 55: using **B**, *p4, m1, p5, rep from * to last 2sts, p2 112sts

Change to patt 2

Row 56: *k1, t2R, rep from * to last st, k1

Rows 57-63(65:67:69): patt
Next row cast off 38sts, patt to end

Work 5(6:7:8) more rows in patt.
Cast off

RIGHT FRONT

Using 7mm needles and **C**, cast on 60sts and work as folls:-

Row 1: purl

Row 2: using **B**, knit y2rn to end, cast on 3sts

Row 3: slip all sts undoing y2rn

Row 4: using **C**, spiral 60, k2, inc 64sts

Row 5: using **A**, p1, *p4, ml, p5, rep from * to end 71sts

Change to patt 1

Row 6: * k1, t2L, rep from * to last st, k1, cast on 2sts

Rows 7-16: cont with patt 1, casting on 3sts at end of rows 8, 12 and 16 and casting on 2sts at end of rows 10 and 14 86sts

Row 17: using **C**, p3, *p4, p2tog, p4, rep from * to last 3sts, p3 78sts

Row 18: using **B**, knit y2rn to end, cast on 4sts

Row 19: slip across row undoing y2rn

Row 20: using **C**, spiral 78, k4

Row 21: using **A**, p7, *p7, m1, p8, rep from * to end 87sts

Change to body patt

Row 22: *k3, p1, rep from * to last 3sts, k3, cast on 3sts

Row 23-32: cont with body patt, casting on 2sts at end of rows 24 and 28, casting on 3sts at end of rows 26 and 30 and casting on 12sts at end of row 32 112sts

Rows 33-48: cont with body patt, dec shoulder end on rows 38, 43 and 48 109sts

Row 49: using **C**, p4, * p2tog, p14, rep from * to last 9sts, p2tog, p7 102sts

Rows 50-55: work as left front but dec beg row 53

Change to patt 1

Row 56: *k1, t2L, rep from * to last 2sts, k2

Rows 57-62(64:66:68): cont with patt

Next row: cast off 38sts, patt to end

Work 5(6:7:8) more rows in patt.
Cast off

LEFT HALF COLLAR

Using 6mm needles and **C**, cast on 126sts

Rows 1-15: change to **A** and work in fisherman rib as on back

Row 16: rib 72, turn

Row 17: s1, rib to end

Row 18: rib 68, turn

Row 19: s1, rib to end

Row 20: rib 64, turn

Row 21: s1, rib to end

Row 22: rib 60, turn

Row 23: s1, rib to end

Cont as set, ribbing 4sts LESS on alt rows to completion of row 41

Rows 42-53: rib across all sts

Row 54: rib 4, * p2tog, p1, p2tog k1, rep from * seven MORE times, rib to end

Row 55: rib 15sts, cast off remaining sts.

On 15sts cont with rib until work fits across lower left front

RIGHT HALF COLLAR

Work as for left half collar BUT

Row 1: *p1, k1, rep from *

Row 54: rib 4, *p2tog, k1, p2tog p1, rep from * seven times more, rib to end

BELT

Using 6mm needles and **A**, cast on 13sts and work 150(155:160:165) cm, 59(61:63:65)ins in k1, p1, rib.

Cast off

FINISHING

Weave in any loose ends. Sew shoulder seams. Join collars at centre back. Carefully pin collar around fronts and lower front edges, sew into place. Sew side and sleeve seams. Set in sleeves and stitch into place. Press work using a warm iron over a damp cloth.

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
